

# Tenant's Guide, Checklist & Key Dates



#### Tenant Checklist:

I have read through and am content with the agreement and with the information that has been inserted into the Tenancy Agreement I have inserted my contact details into the agreement and the landlord has done so also. I have been given a copy of the Government's 'How to Rent' guide and I have read and understood my rights and responsibilities. I have been given a gas safety certificate, if there is a gas installation. I have been given deposit paperwork, if I have provided a deposit. I have been given the Energy Performance Certificate (unless a valid exemption applies). I have been given a copy of a report showing that the property's electrical installations have been inspected and any necessary remedial works have been completed. If I have paid a tenancy deposit, I have received the prescribed information about in which of the Government approved tenancy deposit protection schemes my deposit is protected within 30 days of paying the tenancy deposit. I have paid a deposit no greater than 5 weeks rent where the total annual rent is less than £50,000, or 6 weeks' rent were the total annual rent is £50,000 or above. If I am responsible for paying for utilities I have been given meter readings by the landlord and understand that I am responsible for any consumption of gas, electricity and water (and oil if applicable) above the initial readings. If I am responsible for Council Tax, I have informed the council.



### **Key Dates:**

- Rent due date (insert date e.g. 1st of every month)
- ▶ Rent review dates (if it has been agreed that the landlord can review the rent annually, you may want to make a note of the latest date by which the landlord can send you a notice setting out the new rent for the forthcoming year and a note of the tenancy anniversary dates – see clause B6):
- ▶ Deadline for comments on the inventory and/or report of condition if there is one (See clause B9):
- Date on which fixed term tenancy ends (see clause B4.1):
- Date that first RIGHT TO RENT check was undertaken
- ▶ Date that any subsequent RIGHT TO RENT check is due (only applicable where a tenant has limited right to rent).
